Sales tax holiday period is August 7–9, 2020.

To qualify for the tax exemption, the purchase must be made during the sales tax holiday period by an individual for personal use. The first \$1000 of the sales price of the qualified item are exempted. Any item that costs in excess of \$1000 will be taxed on the portion of the price that is over \$1000. Computers (including iPad and iPod) and computer accessories qualify for this holiday.
